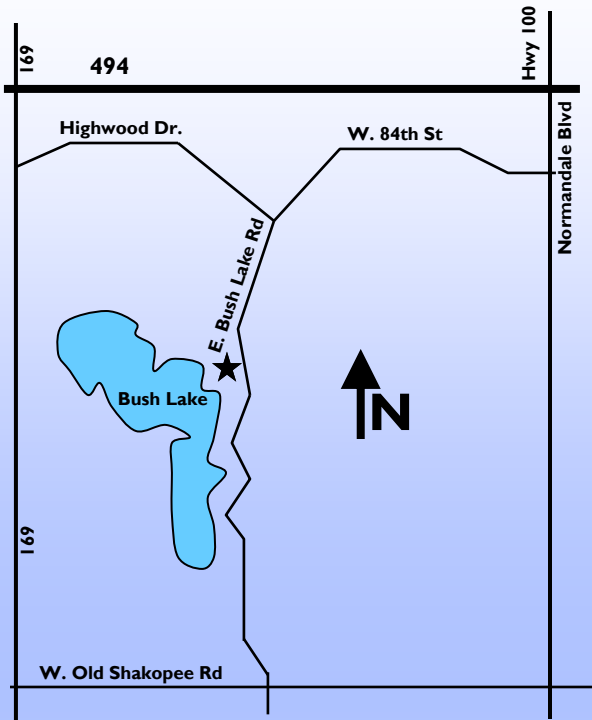


# BUSH LAKE BEACH



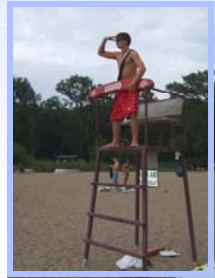
## DIRECTIONS TO BUSH LAKE BEACH

**From 169:**  
Exit at Old Shakopee Road and travel east to Bush Lake Road. Go north on Bush Lake Road. Follow Bush Lake Road to East Bush Lake Road and follow East Bush Lake Road to the Beach.

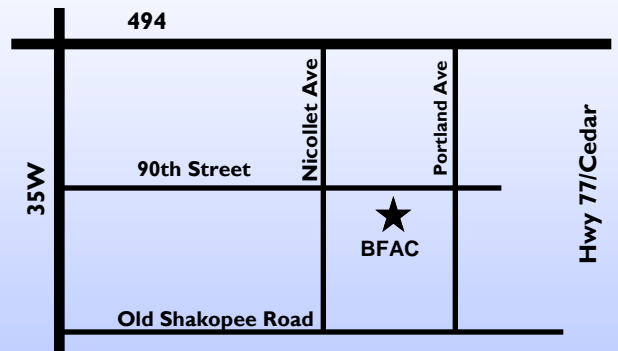
**From 494:**  
Exit at Hwy 100 and travel south to 84th Street. Go west on 84th street. You will pass the ski jump, up the hill, and continue on the same road (becomes East Bush Lake Road. Follow to the beach.

# BLOOMINGTON FAMILY AQUATIC CENTER

Come and enjoy a summer at the Bloomington Family Aquatic Center! Experience our zero-depth entry, beached boat slide, tumble buckets, jet spray, diving boards, drop slide, and the thrilling, looping waterslides. If you get hungry, come visit our concessions stand.

## ADMISSION POLICY

Children under 11 years of age will only be allowed into the Bloomington Family Aquatic Center if;

- The child is accompanied by an adult 18 years of age or older,

**OR**

- The child is accompanied by a responsible party (sibling, babysitter, or nanny) who is at least 16 years of age and has a completed "Guardian Permission Form" signed by the child's guardian on file at the pool. The responsible party cannot be responsible for supervising more than four children between the ages of 5-10 at one time or more than 1 child under 5 years of age. Staff recommends an adult or responsible party being within reasonable reach of the child at all times while in or immediately adjacent to the water.

## BFAC GROUP RESERVATIONS

Discounted admissions are available for groups over 20. Reservations must be made 2 weeks in advance. Call 952-563-8877 for more information and to make a reservation.

## BIRTHDAY PARTIES

To ensure your visit is both safe and enjoyable please follow the Rules below:

All swimmers must have a swimsuit in order to swim in the pool.

- \* This includes an appropriate top and bottom for females and appropriate swim trunks for males.
- \* Swim Diapers are required for children that are not potty-trained.

Concessions:

- \* Concessions are available for purchase inside the facility.
- \* Picnics space is available inside & outside of the pool fence.

THE FOLLOWING ARE NOT ALLOWED:

- Tobacco and Alcohol use
- Snorkels, Fins and Balls
- Inflated articles and floatation equipment EXCEPT for U.S. Coast Guard Type I-III approved floatation devices, with an adult 18 years of age or older within arms reach at all times.
- Horseplay and Running.
- Diving off pool sides
- Open cuts or communicable diseases
- Glass containers
- Animals

WATER SLIDE RULES:

- Walk up the stairs
- One person at a time in each flume
- Hands and feet must be kept inside
- No diving at the end of the slide
- No standing, kneeling, rotating or stopping
- Use the ladder closest to the slide
- Follow all the instructions of the attendants
- Adults may catch their children in the water at the bottom of the slide

DIVING WELL RULES:

- Exit the diving well promptly
- One bounce on the board
- One person on the board at a time
- One person on the ladder at a time
- Swim to the closest ladder after diving off the boards
- Walking down any ladder is prohibited

## PARKING PERMITS

In order to park your car at Bush Lake Beach, a daily or seasonal parking permit must be purchased and affixed to your windshield of your car, June 1 through August 31.

Daily permits are sold at the beach only. For fee information, see insert.

## CONCESSIONS

For the enjoyment of the Beach & Park patrons, a concession operation is available full of all the goodies one could imagine. Stop by for an ice cream treat or a refreshing soft drink.

Concessions are open during beach hours only.

## A HEALTHY BEACH....

For the safety of our swimmers, Bush Lake Beach water is tested several times per week by certified microbiologists. The Beach may be closed if the level of bacteria become too high.

We can all do our part to continue to make Bush Lake Beach a healthy place to swim...

- Use swim diapers on swimmers who need them.
- Take a shower before and after swimming.
- Avoid drinking or "spouting" beach water.
- Use safety breaks to use the restrooms.
- Wash hands after using the restroom.
- Wash hands after swimming, especially before eating.

## BUSH LAKE BEACH RULES:

- Swimmers under 11 years of age must be accompanied by an adult.
- Swimming only in authorized beach area.
- Inflated articles and floatation equipment are not allowed EXCEPT for U.S. Coast Guard Type I-III approved floatation devices, with an adult 18 years of age or older within arms reach at all times.
- Glass containers are not allowed.
- Throwing rocks or sand is prohibited.
- No running or pushing from docks.
- Swimming under docks is prohibited.
- Dogs are not permitted in beach area.
- No smoking or alcohol use
