

Position Title: Program Specialist – Teen Volunteers **Date:** Summer 2022

Department: Parks and Recreation **Division** Recreation

Accountable to: Recreation Supervisor

Primary Objective of Position:

Assist in the implementation, coordination, and supervision of recreation programming, under the supervision of the Recreation Supervisor and work direction of Program Coordinator(s). Provide activities and on-site leadership of staff and teen volunteers at various sites.

Examples of Duties:

- 1. Provide work direction and mentorship to teen volunteers.
- 2. Attend and participate in all staff and volunteer trainings and meetings.
- 3. Assist in facilitating teen volunteer training.
- 4. Participate in, assist in facilitating, and provide leadership at staff orientation sessions.
- 5. Assist in the assignment of volunteers to park and program locations.
- 6. Provide assistance to other Program Specialists and leadership team as needed.
- 7. Provide input for staff evaluations.
- 8. Assist in planning summer programming as directed.
- 9. Teach and promote respect for park facilities and care of program equipment and supplies.
- 10. Teach and promote high standard of participant safety.
- 11. Provides support as needed for all participants and staff to create an inclusive environment onsite.
- 12. Work as a team member to ensure the program's compliance with the Americans with Disabilities Act and the Minnesota Human Rights Act.
- 13. Follow staff policies and procedures.
- 14. Ensure that all staff and program participants follow the policies and procedures.
- 15. Perform special assignments and other work as assigned by Summer Youth Program Coordinators.
- 16. Complete all other duties as assigned by Recreation Supervisor.
- 17. Adhere to and enforce state health guidelines.

Minimum Qualifications:

- 1. Must be 18 years of age or older
- 2. Must be available the entire season from June 20 August 12 (Monday-Friday), with limited time off requests.
- 3. Must be able to attend leadership training and assist in facilitating/preparing for staff training June $13^{th} 17^{th}$ and complete online training.
- 4. Must successfully pass a Criminal and Driving Background Check.

- 5. Must have experience working with children/teens.
- 6. Currently certified in First Aid/CPR/AED, or have ability to obtain.

Desirable Qualifications:

- 1. Supervisory and/or Leadership experience, particularly with teens.
- 2. One or more years of college and experience working in community recreation or education programs.
- 3. Ability to work independently with minimum supervision.
- 4. Willingness to learn about and support people with disabilities as they participate fully in City sponsored Parks and Recreation programs.
- 5. A positive role model who can serve as a mentor to teen volunteers.
- 6. Knowledge and understanding of child behavior, experience in recreation and an ability to relate with and supervise children successfully
