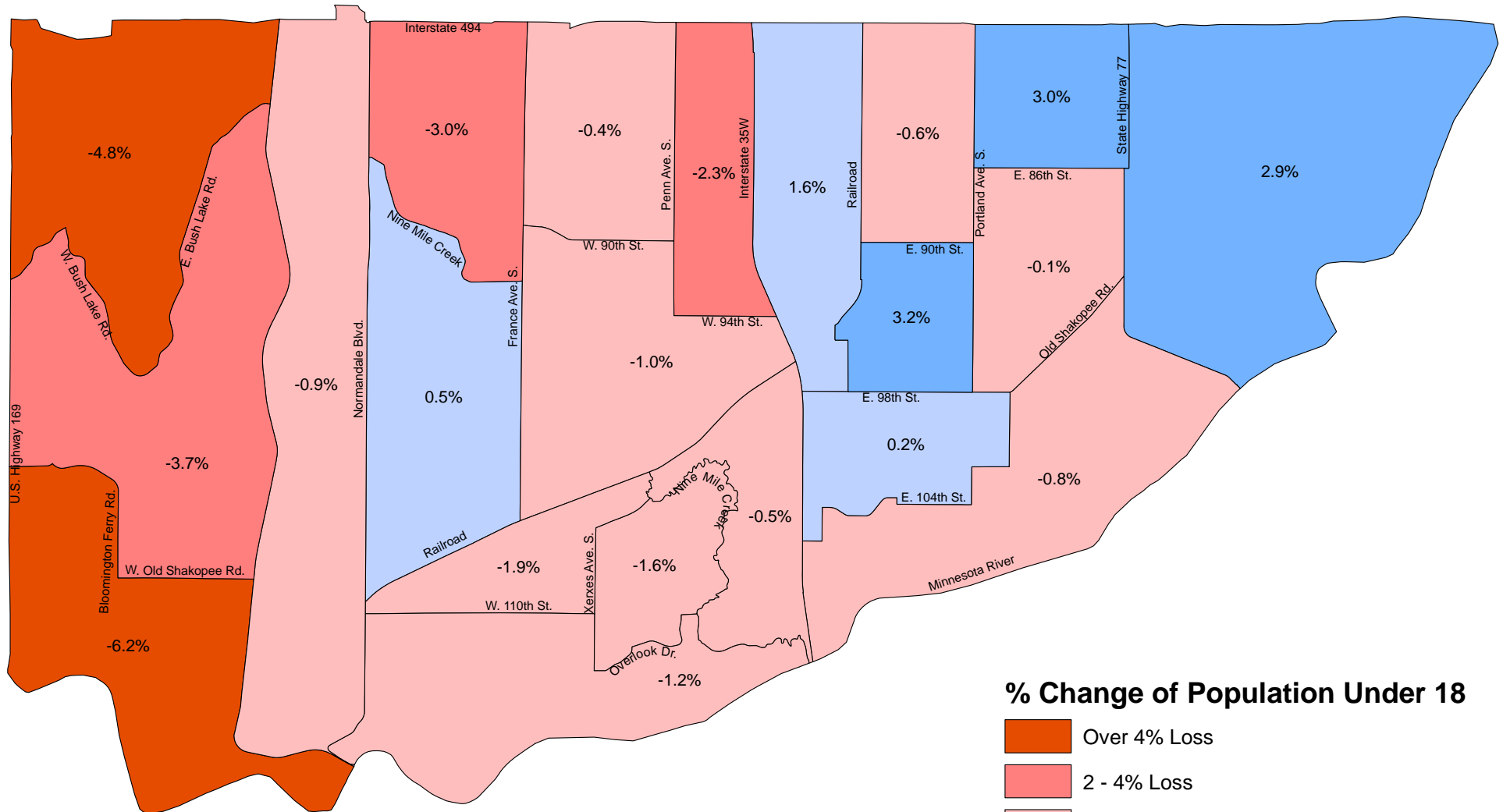
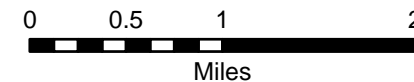


# City of Bloomington Percent Change of Population Under 18 2000 - 2010
