

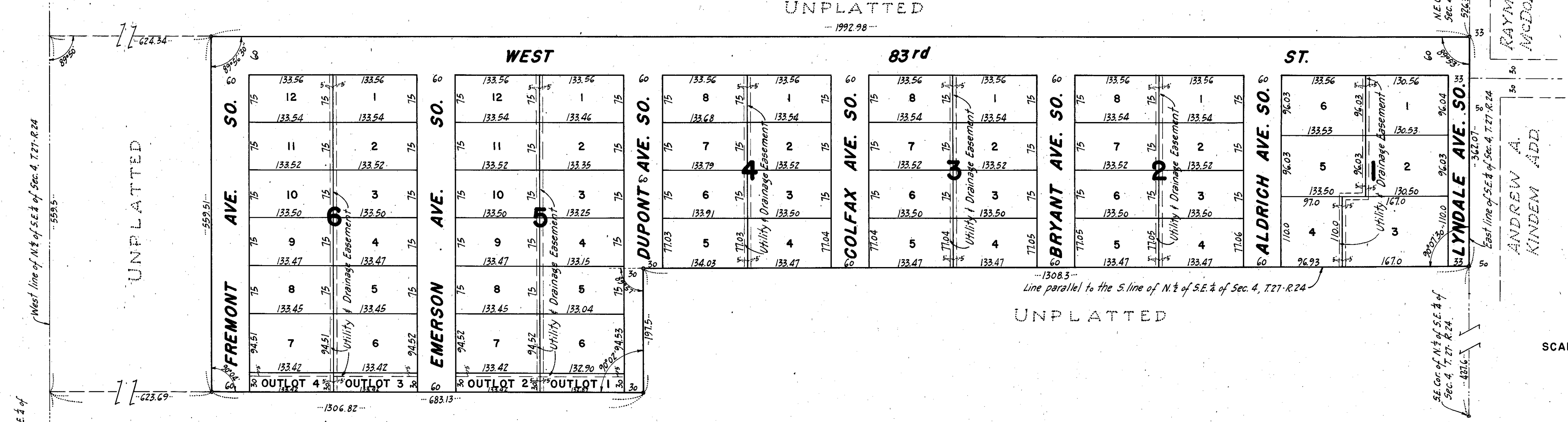

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That E.J. Eliason and Alma Eliason, husband and wife, and Richard J. Pahl and Margaret E. Pahl, husband and wife, owners and proprietors of the following described property situated in the State of Minnesota and County of Hennepin, to-wit:

That part of the North One-half (N 1/2) of the Southeast Quarter (S.E. 1/4) of Section Four (4), Township Twenty-seven (27), Range Twenty-four (24) West of the 4th Principal Meridian described as follows:

Beginning at a point on the East line of the S.E. 1/4 of Section 4, T. 27-R. 24, 427.6 feet North of the Southeast corner of the North 1/2 of the S.E. 1/4 of said Section 4, thence West on a line parallel to the South line of said North 1/2 a distance of 1308.3 feet, thence South 197.5 feet to a point 1306.82 feet East of the West line of the North 1/2 of the S.E. 1/4 of said Section 4, thence West 683.13 feet on a line which if extended would intersect the West line of the North 1/2 of the S.E. 1/4 of said Section 4 a distance of 230.4 feet North of the Southwest corner thereof, thence North a distance of 559.51 feet to a point 624.34 feet East of the West line of said North 1/2, thence East a distance of 1992.98 feet to a point on the East line of said S.E. 1/4 a distance of 526.3 feet South of the Northeast corner thereof, thence South along the East line of said S.E. 1/4 to the point of beginning.

Have caused the same to be surveyed and platted as BLOOMFIELD ADDITION and do hereby donate and dedicate to the public for public use forever, the street and avenues as shown on the annexed plat, and also subject to utility and drainage easements as shown on the annexed plat.
