1. Building permit fee

The building valuation used to establish building permit fees is the most current data published by the International Conference of Building Officials in their building standards publication. The fee schedule is on the back of this page.
2. Surcharge

The State of Minnesota requires the City of Bloomington to collect a surcharge on all building permits. The surcharge is calculated as follows:

## 3. Plan checking fees

If the valuation of the proposed construction exceeds $\$ 10,000,000$ and a plan is required to be submitted by Chapter 15, a plan checking fee must be paid to the issuing authority when the plans and specifications are submitted for checking. The fee is equal to 65 percent of the building permit fee as set in the Bloomington City Code, Section 15.183, Subdivision (a). A fee of $\$ 48$ per hour, with a half hour minimum fee, is charged for any additional plan review required by changes, additions or revisions to approved plans. ## 4. Certificate of occupancy

The fee is calculated as follows:

5. Service Availability Charges (SAC)

Charges for buildings other than single family homes are determined by Metropolitan Council. https://metrocouncil.org.

For new construction, the fees are paid at the time of building permit issuance. For existing buildings or tenant spaces that have undergone a Change of Use, per the building code, a SAC review is required and again, the fee is paid at the time of building permit issuance.
