

## Tent/Canopy Requirements Information Sheet

- 1. A permit is required for tents, canopies and membrane structures having an area in excess of 400 square feet.
- Tents or membrane structures shall not be located within 20 feet of lot lines, buildings, other tents or membrane structures, parked vehicles or internal combustion engines.
- 3. Traffic circulation and fire lanes must be maintained.
- 4. Tents/canopies must be of an approved type and conform with provisions of the *Minnesota State Fire Code and Chapter 6*, *Article II of the City of Bloomington Code of Ordinances*.
- 5. The tent area and surrounding 30 feet must be clear of combustibles.
- 6. If cooking or serving food, contact Environmental Services at 952-563-8934. Cooking and open flame devices are not allowed inside the tent.
- 7. Provide a letter describing the event.
- 8. Provide a site plan showing:
  - Location of all tent/canopy(s)
  - Size of all tent/canopy(s)
  - Parking
  - Fire lane provisions
  - · Distances to structures and lot/property lines

- 9. If applicable, provide an interior plan showing:
  - Exiting/signs
  - Stage location and size
  - Fire extinguishers
  - Trash collection
  - Seating
  - Electrical/exit lighting
  - Heating
  - Floor covering
- 10. Refer to *Bloomington City Code*, *Section 19.63.06*, for additional information.
- 11. Call the Fire Prevention Division at 952-563-8933 for an inspection of the tent/canopy once it is set up and prior to the event.
