



PROJECT SUMMARY

The six-story, 402 unit The Fenley apartment project was developed by McGough Development. It opened in phases starting in April 2020 with all units open by August 2020. The project is part of Bloomington Central Station, a master-planned, 50-acre transit-oriented development that's being developed by McGough Development. The project has mostly market-rate units with 40 units affordable to those making 80% AMI. It offers numerous amenities including a fitness center, yoga/on demand workout studio, a sauna, an outdoor swimming pool, club room, work-from-home café, meeting spaces, library lounge, a sky-lounge, multiple fire pits and gas grilling stations, LuxerOne package delivery system, and a pet-spa/washing station for residents' pets. The project features multiple courtyards including landscaped seating areas, BBQ/ grilling stations, pool terrace seating, pergolas, and bocce court. It is located to the north of the two Reflections condominium towers, south of the IndiGO apartment project, and east of the Bloomington Central Station park. It has convenient access to the Minnesota Valley National Wildlife Refuge.
